JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Produces quality tubing by ensuring established production goals are met, to include: Ensuring tube is cut to correct length (ID and OD). Transferring, cutting, chamfering, inspecting, loading & unloading tube. Performing changeover of machine specifications to adjust sizing of tubing according to customer's order Operating gage and tooling controls. Identifying and recording problems and initiating resolution. Continuous visual inspection of tube for scratches, cracks, rust, dirt & oil. Adhering to safety guidelines. Keeping work area clean. May be required to operate overhead crane or forklift. Performs other assigned duties as necessary.

WORKING CONDITIONS/PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Exposure to loud noise levels, dust, heat and cold and various chemicals while in plant area (lubricants, cutting fluids, drawing oils). Stooping, reaching, climbing and lifting up to 50 lbs. Ability to stand for long periods of time. Safety shoes, earplugs, hard hat and safety glasses are a requirement to be worn at all times while in the plant along with long sleeves or covered arms.
